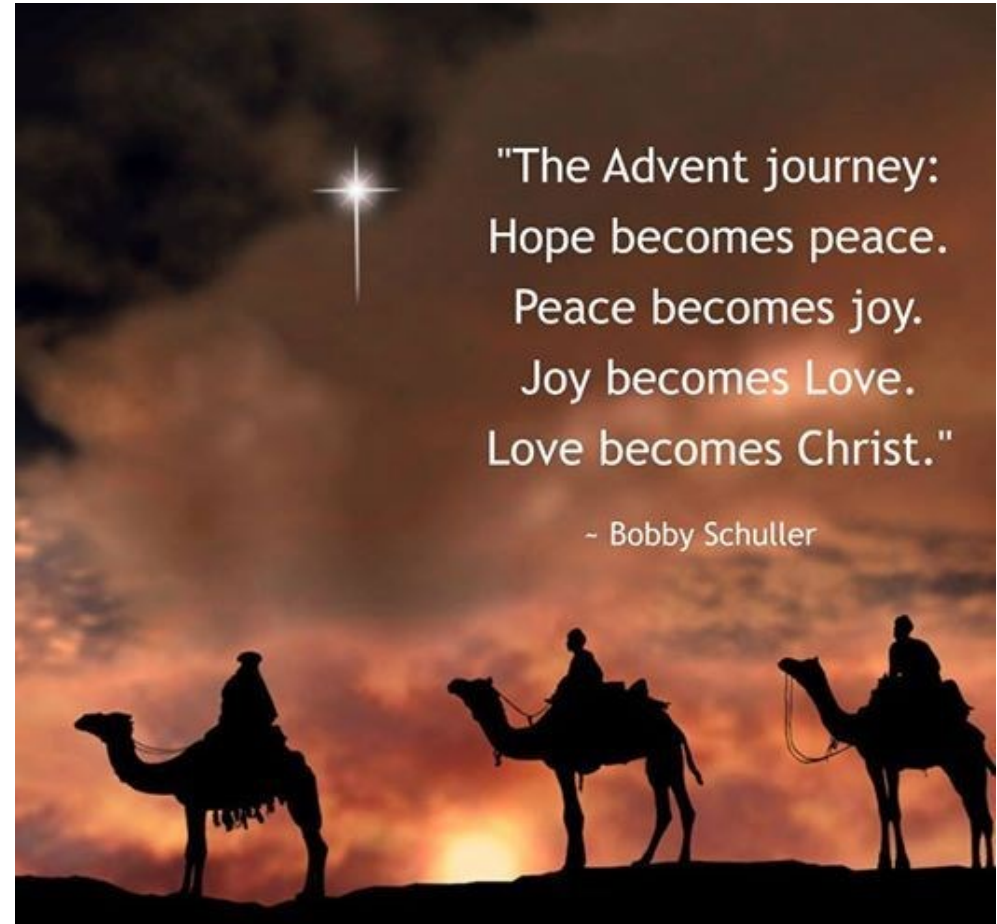


NPC WEEKLY OR MONTHLY EVENTS
