- ☑ **Friendship Friday** is an informal Potluck Dinner with family and friends, a time to socialize and play some games, **May 17 - 6 pm**

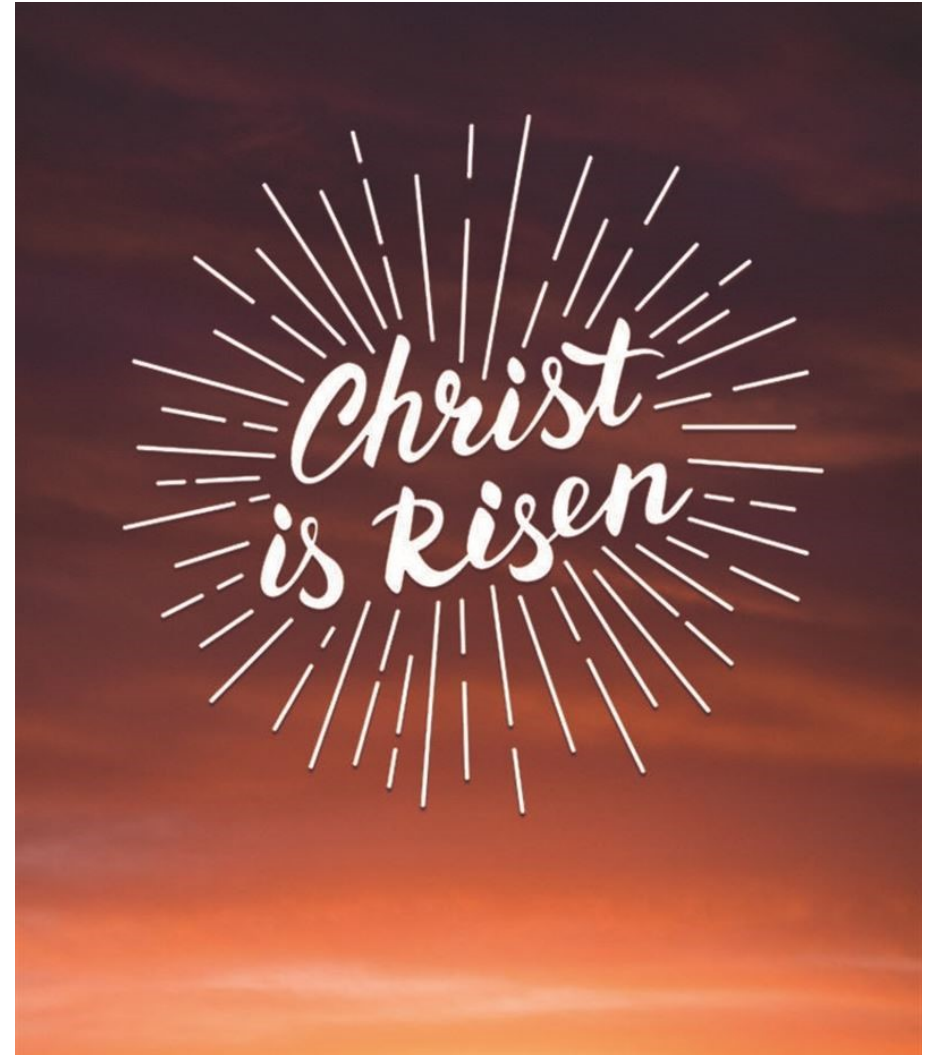
