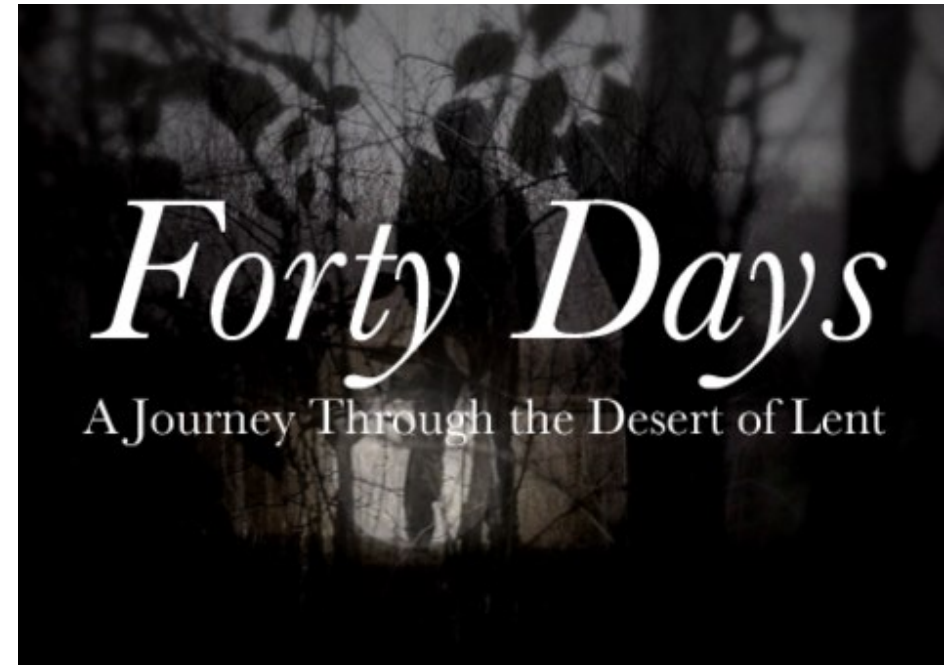


**HAPPENINGS AT NPC .....**
