

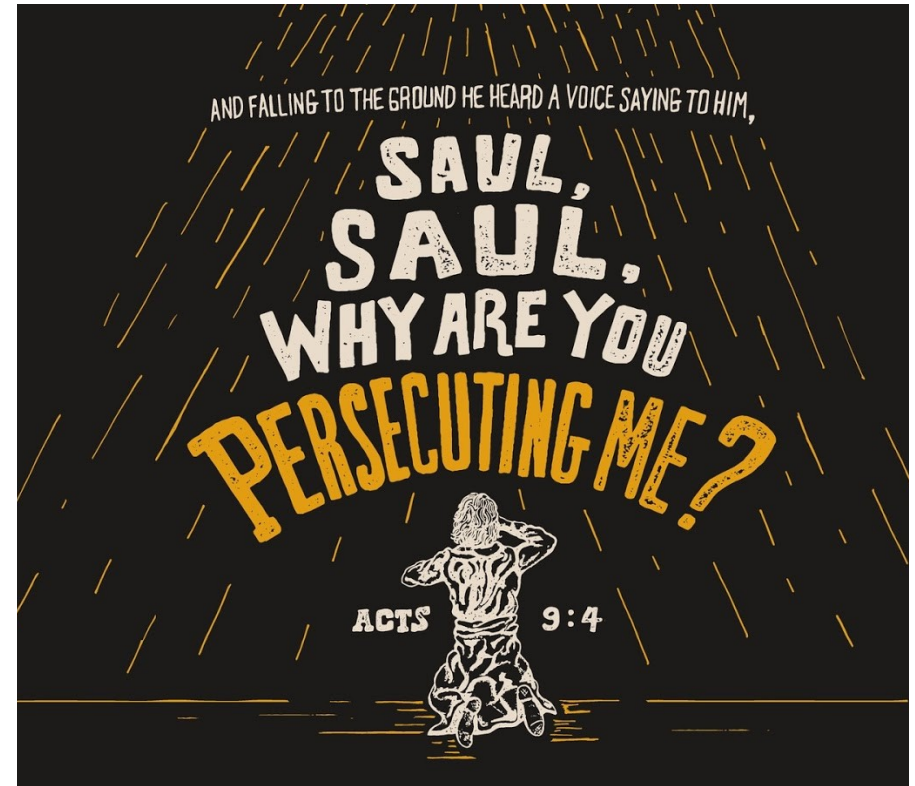
HAPPENINGS AT NPC
